1. Articulatory Phonetics — studies production of speech sounds.
2. Acoustic Phonetics — studies transmission of sounds between the speaker and a listener.
3. Auditory Phonetics — examines how sounds are perceived by a listener.

Phonetics offers the means to develop good pronunciation through enhanced awareness of relevant aspects of speech. It becomes a mix of theoretical and practical skills (transcription skills, ear-training, production-training, etc.). Pronunciation must be learned in parallel with meaning and use for every new word. Through the Phonetics method, the students are taught about phonetics, speech organs, and rules in a scientific manner. They recognize speech sounds, make sounds, practice and use sounds in their speech.
