Difference between Bilingual Method and Translation Method are described below :

Bilingual Method	Translation Method
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. It makes use of the mother-tongue in a restricted manner. 2. The teacher alone uses the mother-tongue to explain meaning etc. and not the pupil. 3. Pupils are given a lot of practice in the drill of sentence patterns. 4. It is an improved method of teaching English. 5. Pupils have greater practice in speaking English. 6. This method is more suitable to the pupils who speak regional languages. 7. There is greater understanding of English on the part of the pupils. 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. It makes excessive use of the mother-tongue. 2. The teacher as well as the pupils use the mother-tongue in explaining the sentences, meanings etc. 3. Pupils are not given any practice in the drill of sentence patterns. 4. There is not much improvement in this method. 5. Pupils have less practice in speaking English. 6. This method is not suitable to the pupils who speak regional languages. 7. The understanding on the part of the pupils is less in learning through this method.
