

MLPA (Multi level planning Approach)

These agencies at national level planning (national target is fixed).

- ① NITI Nayog/Planning Commission of India
- ② NDC - National Development Council
- ③ Central cabinet

National - State → ~~SDB~~ → District → CDB - PRI

Constitutionally district is administrative unit to perform judiciary, revenue collection and dev. work.

Dist. board on the recommendation of Bahadur Mehta Committee report - 1956. (CDB) - failed to act satisfactorily - DM has all the powers.

M.P. dist. - Goes to DM (fund)

PRI — Zila Parishad — District level  
— Paradeyat Samiti — Block level  
— Gram Paradeyat — Village level.

ZP (Dist level Plan) — ZP (dist. level plan to be prepared by ZP. (ZP = all elected members,

MPs, MLAs, MLGs) all district officers associated to dev. work. Elected members have to elect the chairman.

ZP - It has to approve dist. plan & give guidelines for dev. has to approve allocations for diff. blocks, decide priorities for those projects which would benefit.

one panchayat or one block. (Canal, houses & dist. roads)  
→ preparatory work of DLP is to be done by  
a committee of experts in consultation with  
block and panchayat authorities, important work  
is to be monitored and co-ordinated by DDO/DPD.  
All supervising powers is delegated to ~~DDO~~ Z.P  
Chairman and financial control powers to DM/DCS.

### ② Block level & panchayat level planning

2400 - ~~CB~~ CDBs - (~~1953-53~~)

1977 - Sarkarwala Committee was constituted to recommend  
the functional viability of the blocks. (Kuro - continuation)

Blocks as an <sup>agent</sup> ~~agent of central govt.~~ & b/w DLP & PLP.

Blocks empowered to create Micro level planning (MLP)

BAO (Block Agricultural Officer) suppose to prepare the  
blueprint of development.

20 centres in an every block as service centre where

✓ essential infrastructural facilities were to be developed

They function as regulated market centres.



- Panchayat Raj Institution (PRIs)

Each block would be assisted by Panchayat Samiti for development of guidelines for dev.

Panchayat Samiti - All Mukhligas of the block / representative Panchayats, elected members of the block areas and the block development authorities, officers concerned for dev. of the block (BAO & BDO)

Pramukh is also the member of Zila Parishad where the development needs of blocks are to be discussed / presented.

PS - Responsibility to co-ordinate the development work of various Panchayats.

- To initiate such dev. work which can benefit more than one Panchayat.
